Our vision for 2023 is to amplify the strength, power, and worth inherent in each child so that they can experience safety, have access to education, and live in a more equitable world where they can thrive.

Here's a breakdown of what your gift will go toward:

Counseling: \$15,000

Individual and group counseling sessions, psychosocial trainings, child safety trainings, trauma process groups

Education: \$25,000
