We have served 116 children through our scholarship program to date and look to bring in an additional 20 students this upcoming year.

We're dedicated to supporting emotional, spiritual, and psychological healing from trauma for children and their families through individual counseling sessions, small group support, and psychosocial education.

WHAT YOUR GIFTS CAN DO

\$25 provides school uniforms for one BEAM scholar.

\$400 covers tuition and school supplies for a BEAM scholar in day school.

\$800 covers tuition, supplies, and personal needs for a BEAM scholar in boarding school.

\$25 provides one counseling session for a vulnerable child.

\$100 supports one psychosocial education program led by our counseling team on topics such as problem solving, decision making, teamwork, and communication.

\$400 covers an academic workshop with the BEAM scholars and their guardians.

\$25 provides a month's worth of food for a child-headed household or a child in foster care.


