The chance to help kids be kids

Joseph (name changed to protect privacy) was first referred to BEAM Kenya by his teacher, who was concerned about ongoing medical issues. After several home visits, our social work team uncovered a deeper reality: Joseph was being abused by his father.

He and his two siblings were removed from an unsafe home and received the care they urgently needed. After thorough family reunification efforts, they spent school holidays with their maternal grandmother, and BEAM provided boarding school tuition during the term to ensure their safety

and stability. Over the past year, our counseling team has supported Joseph and his siblings on their journey toward healing and hope.

We pursue justice and fight for change because we know abuse often repeats across generations. The World Health Organization confirms that children who experience abuse are more likely to become abusers themselves as adults. By supporting Joseph and his siblings, we can break that toxic cycle.

Stories like Joseph's are possible because of our compassionate community, made up of people who believe that a better world is possible for children—and that

community includes you. During this season of giving and generosity, I hope you consider a gift to continue working toward that better world.

Let's keep pushing forward together, creating even more pathways to education, psychosocial support, mental health care, and safety so kids in Kenya can overcome adversity.

Helping Kids Like Amina



Amina (name changed to protect privacy) is a bright, determined 15-year-old in Grade 4. After her parents separated, she was left without support. Her father neglected her, and her mother's new husband refused to take her in—leading her to go live with other relatives. Though loved, her caregivers couldn't afford school tuition, and she was often sent home from class.

When BEAM social workers met Amina, they saw both her struggle and her potential. She was granted an academic scholarship, giving her the chance to return to school. At first, Amina found it difficult to adjust. She sat quietly at the back of the classroom—withdrawn, avoiding eye contact, and rarely speaking. Some classmates whispered about her, commenting on her age and wondering why she was always alone. But Amina kept showing up.

Our counseling team supported Amina, helping her gradually open up about her sleepless nights, losses, and the heavy emotions she carried. Session by session, she learned to name her feelings—fear, anger, and sadness—and began to heal. She also learned breathing techniques and journaling, gradually gaining confidence.

Amina now speaks up in class and was recently appointed to a class leadership position. She enjoys singing in her church choir. Her journey reflects resilience and renewal, and with continued support, she is healing, growing, and embracing a hope-filled future.
